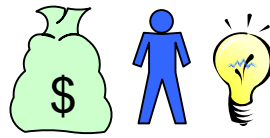

Minimum requirements for setting up a Company in Malaysia

- Minimum Authorised Capital of RM 100,000/-
- Minimum Paid-up Capital of RM 2/-
- At least 2 Directors who must be resident in Malaysia.
- Qualified Company Secretary as required by Section 139 of Companies Act 1965.
- Other compliance of post incorporation relating to the requirement of the Companies Act 1965 in respect of yearly compliance of Annual General Meeting (AGM), Tax Compliance, Employers' Obligations, Foreign Investment Committee (FIC) compliance, Work Permit compliance, Licensing etc.
